Preparation


To get started, open the WeldVR hard case and take out the items you'll need: the Quest VR headset and controllers, link cable, and welding extensions.



Cast to Web

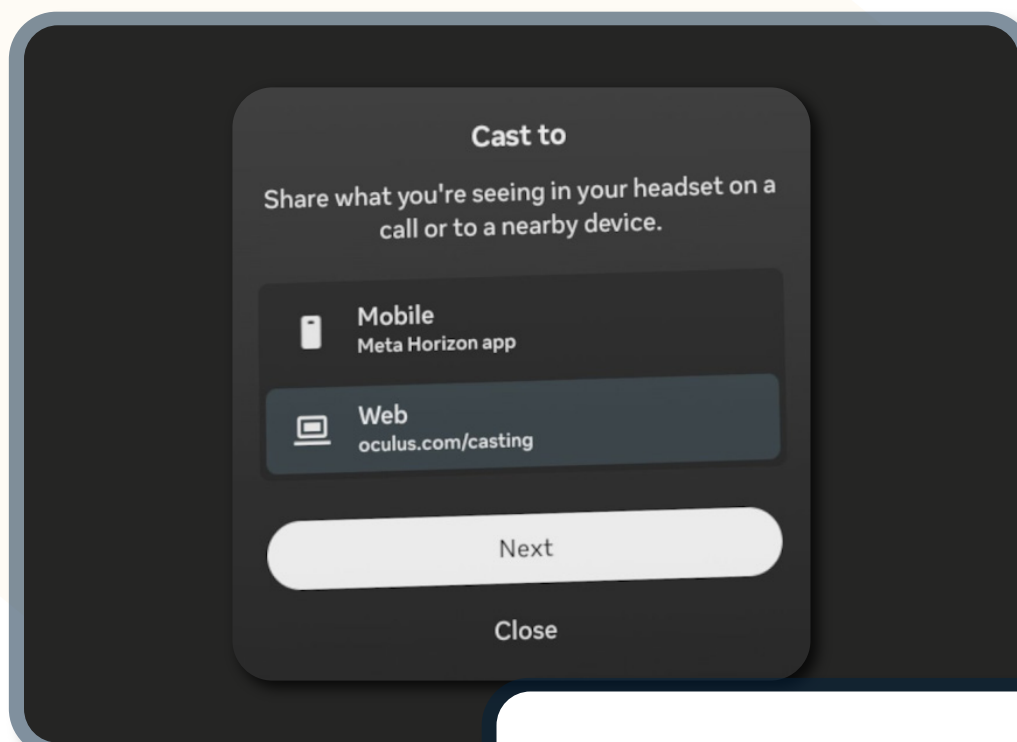
Your computer must be on the same Wi-Fi network as your headset to cast with Meta Quest.

On your computer, open your browser then go to www.oculus.com/casting and log in with Meta Account.


Put your headset on and press  on your controller to open the universal menu.


Select **Camera** , select **Cast**

Select **Web** then select **Next** to connect.

 Go to **Camera**

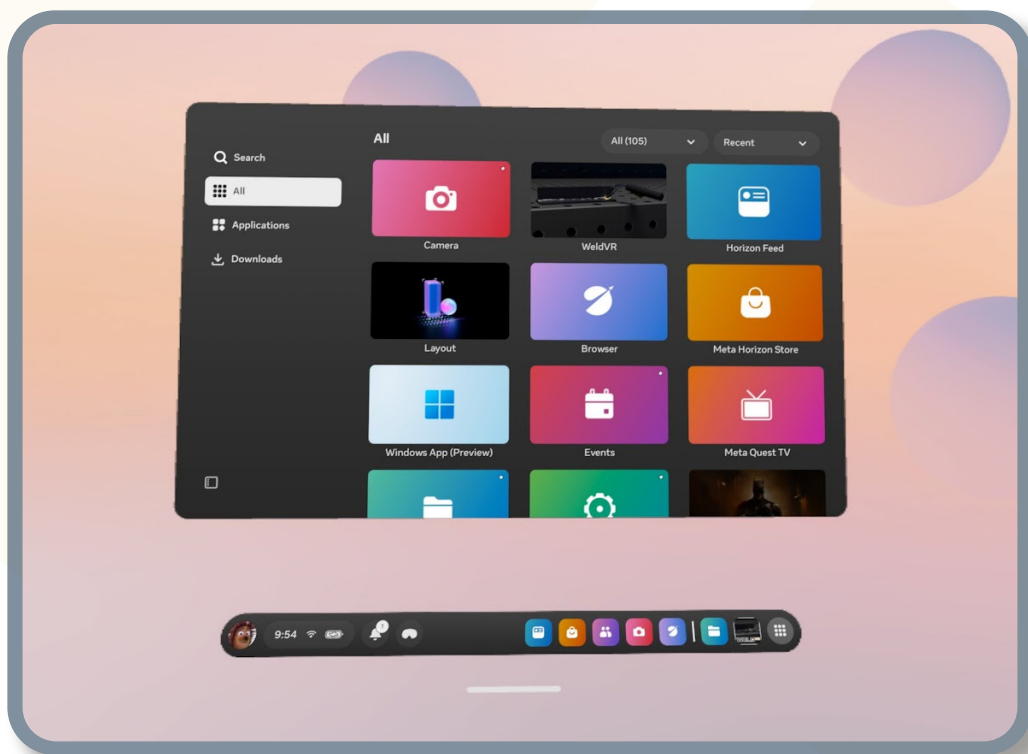
 Select **Cast**

 Select **Computer**

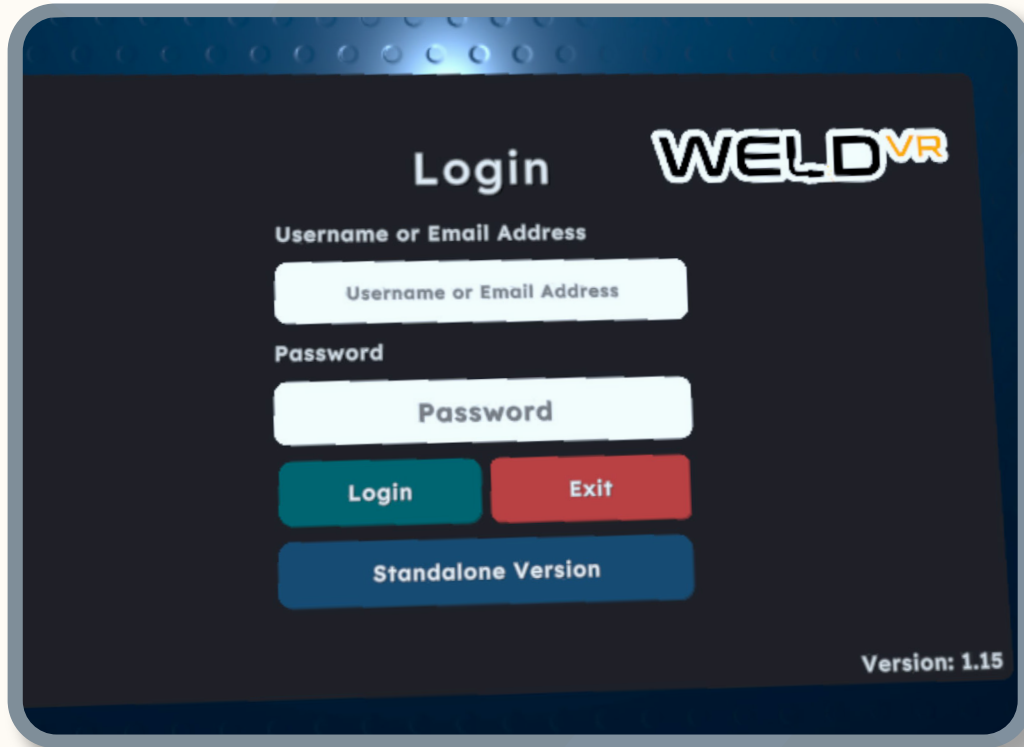

Launching WeldVR

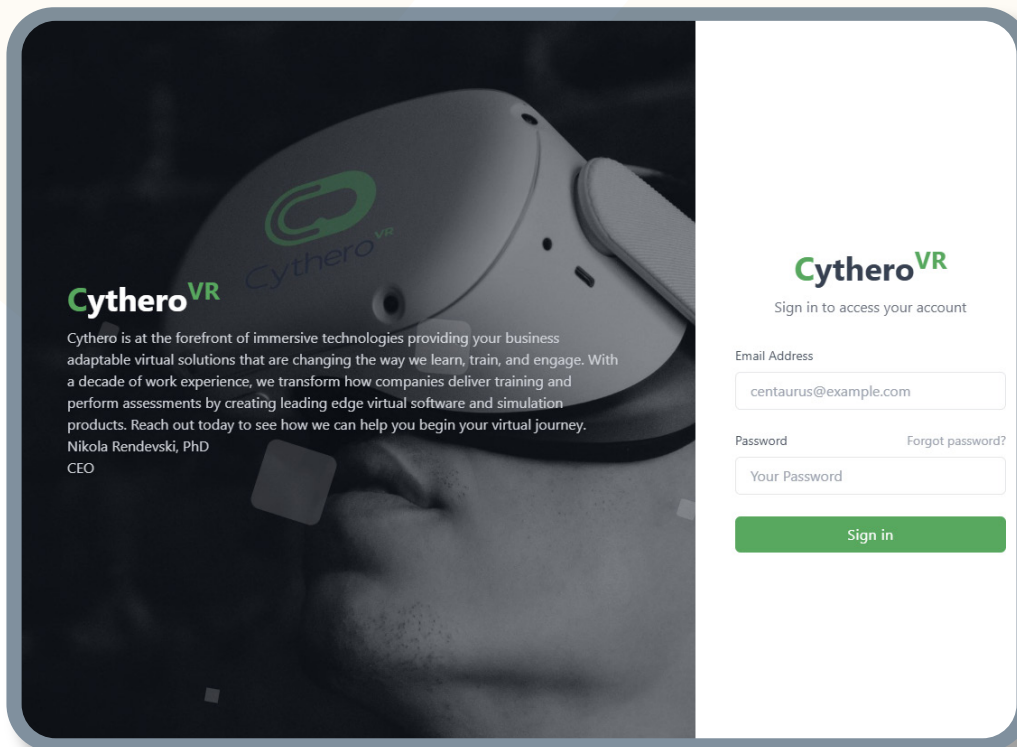
Locate the WeldVR App in the installed Applications Menu on your Meta Quest Headset and launch it by clicking on it.



Enterprise Mode




The Enterprise Version enables logging in and creating multiple user accounts within your organization, with tools to track individual user progress. It includes a web-based administration panel for managing users, organization settings, and active VR devices.




The web-based administration panel is designed to manage users, configure organization settings, track trainee progress, oversee active VR devices, and generate detailed reports.

Log in with trainee profile

After logging in, you will be prompted to choose a trainee profile from the list on the left side and enter a 4-digit PIN to access the selected profile.
